POWERSOUTH MIRACLE LEAGUE FIELD AT JOHNSON PARK—ANDALUSIA, ALA. Installed April 2013







This Miracle League project replaced one of Andalusia's youth field's turf with a rubberized surface to benefit an estimated 400 players and built an inclusive playground to welcome children and families of all abilities. By opening day, businesses, foundations, civic groups and individuals have given or pledged more than \$600,000 in order to create an inclusive environment in the community.

This complex includes the *Everybody Can Play* playground, which features an inclusive PlayBooster[®] Vibe[™] playstructure in vibrant colors, many multisensory playground components and PebbleFlex[®] playground safety surfacing. Especially unique to the complex is a concrete statue of The Miracle League's mascot, Homer.
